Sunflower Seed Pate

Preparation time: 30 minutes
Bake time: One hour
Makes 16 pieces

1 cup raw sunflower seeds, ground

½ cup brown rice flour ½ cup nutritional yeast flakes
1/4 cup extra virgin olive oil
2 tbsp. lemon juice
2 tbsp. Bragg's All Purpose Seasoning®, or soy sauce
1 cup very hot filtered water
3 green onions, finely minced

1 medium carrot, finely grated
2 garlic cloves, minced

2 tsp. each of basil and thyme
1/2 tsp. Celtic ocean salt
A light sprinkle of cayenne

1. Gather all ingredients. In a mixing bowl stir everything together in the order given.
2. Shape the pate, and pour into an 8 x 8 pan lightly coated with olive oil.
3. Sprinkle with sunflower seeds to garnish, and bake for one hour at 300 degrees.

Education - Don't look for it in the School System!

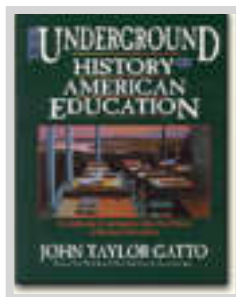
Have you ever wondered:

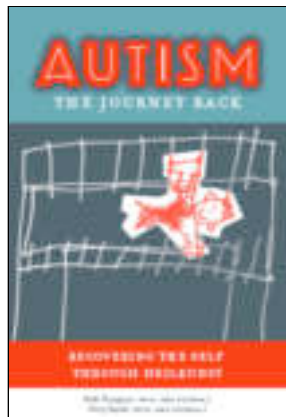
Our autism book is now available!
